ROYAL BROUGHAM SPORTS LEGEND AWARD

This award recognizes an individual with ties to Washington State for a lifetime of exceptional achievement in sports and who exemplifies the spirit of sports as a positive role model for others.

The award was named in honor of Seattle Post-Intelligencer sports editor and creator of Sports Star, Royal Brougham. In his 68-year tenure at the Seattle P-I, Brougham covered many of the 20th century's biggest sporting events, including the University of Washington men's crew at the Berlin Olympics, and established himself as one of Seattle's most celebrated journalists. He returned those sentiments as a passionate advocate for the city of Seattle, using his influence to raise money for charities and creating living memorials in the form of playfields to remember lost military. Nine decades of Sports Star is due to Broughams' determination to create a permanent home and celebration of the legendary moments that make Washington sports so special.
